With few, balanced gestures, he penetrates with amazing talent Testori's words, revealing their most intimate resonances, and being successful in making the loser, humiliated and betrayed Consonni's world vibrate. Cei also gives the reality around Consonni the depth of a nightmare and his feelings, a hallucinated mystery.
